APCTP Workshop on Multiferroics

Mr. Qian Chen (D3, Tokunaga Lab.) is going to give a poster presentation at the international workshop on multiferroics held on October 19-21 at the Hongo Campus of the University of Tokyo (http://crystal.k.u-tokyo.ac.jp/14th_apctp/).



He has studied the high-field properties of an Ising antiferromagnet Fe $_2$ Mo $_3$ O $_8$ with a honeycomb lattice and found an unusual six-step structure in the magnetization process before saturation. Furthermore, he observed a similar multi-step structure in magnetic field dependence of the electric polarization and found a giant magnetoelectric effect of up to 12,000 μ C/m 2 .
