

# Area meeting in Himeji

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Three researchers from the Tokunaga Laboratory attended the Area Meeting of 1000 Tesla project held in Himeji over three days from April 24 to 26.

Prof. Tokunaga gave an oral presentation on magnetic field-induced insulating states in the ultra-quantum limit states, while Dr. Kondo presented on future developments in the multilayer quantum Hall state of layered Dirac electron systems.

Mr. Hanai, a second-year master's student, gave a poster presentation on the magnetic-field-induced crystal axis conversion and multistage metamagnetic transitions observed in NdBi, a material known as an antiferromagnetic topological insulator.

With the addition of a new publicly funded researchers to this field, collaborative research is expected to develop further in the future. Please look forward to the progress of our research.
